

MINUTES OF HARLECH COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT THE OLD LIBRARY, HARLECH AT 7.30 P.M. ON 13.05.24

APOLOGIES

PRESENT

There was 6 members of the public present at the start of the meeting and 2 left shortly after the start of the meeting.

Mrs Jane Jones asked to address the Council to bring to their attention the event that is going to take place to unveil the blue plaque in memory of Bryan Hilton-Jones on the 2nd June and asked if the Council would be willing to give a financial donation towards this event.

Ms Annie O'Brien asked if the Members had received her request to speak at the meeting and she stated that she had sent an e-mail outlining what she wanted to discuss with the Members. It was noted that some Members had received the e-mail in question but unfortunately it had gone to the junk folder of other Members. It was agreed that Ms O'Brien send the e-mail again and the matter would be discussed at next month's meeting.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on April 8th 2024 were found to be correct by the majority of Members, but Cllr. Martin Hughes stated that he did not find the minutes correct and had e-mailed the Members outlining the amendments that should be made to them.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Cllr. Martin Hughes stated it should be noted in the minutes that Cllr. Giles Bentham requested a recorded vote with regards to the matters arising from the April minutes which was refused by the Vice-Chair.

Cllr. Martin Hughes stated it should be noted that the Vice Chair should have explained to members of the public why they had to leave the meeting in April.

Cllr. Martin Hughes proposed that the breach of these two Standing Orders will not be repeated.

DECLARATION OF INTEREST

Cllr. Martin Hughes declared a non personal, non prejudicial interest when the financial application for a blue plaque for Major Bryan Hilton-Jones was discussed as he is Treasurer of the Harlech Historical Society and he signed a Personal Declaration of Interest Form.

Cllr. Giles Bentham declared a personal interest when the financial application for a blue plaque for Major Bryan Hilton-Jones was discussed as he has helped with the history of Hilton-Jones and he signed a Personal Declaration of Interest Form.

GWYNEDD COUNCIL MATTERS

The following report was received from Cllr. Annwen Hughes and Cllr. Gwynfor Owen – Cllr. Annwen Hughes reported that since the last meeting that she had been informed that the car charging points were now working in upper Bron y Graig car park. Also she had received an e-mail from Williams Homes the developer of the houses stating that the work of building these houses near Penyrhwylfa estate was starting. She had received an email voicing concern that the owners of motor homes parking on HAL car park overnight were emptying their toilets into the nearby ditch and she had also received pictures showing the difference in the colour of the water in the ditch before the HAL car park and after passing the car park. It was agreed to contact HAL with regards to this matter regarding the motor homes when they park on HAL car park asking what action they are taking with regards to this matter.

She had also been informed that an eye witness saw the owner of a motor home emptying his toilet into the nearby bushes. Following the meeting she had with the Police back in February this year, she was pleased to see that they

were implementing what they had promised by keeping an eye on speeding down Beach Road and also they had arranged for the Traffic Warden to visit the town more often.

Council's Annual Report

The Clerk reported that the Council has to publish an Annual Report for the financial year which has been so because of this she had sent a copy of the Report that she has prepared for the Council to all Members for comment if necessary. It was agreed to include that Audit Wales had published a report which was in the Public Interest with regards to the scam and also budget needed to be changed to precept under the budget heading and the income and expenditure should read 2023/24 and not 2022/23. It was agreed to forward the annual report with the amendments to the Members and asking them to response back in 5 working days before it is published on the Council's website.

It was also stated by the Chairman that any comments the Members have regarding the minutes should be received within 14 working days from the date of the meeting.

Concern was voiced regarding the website and the Chairman agreed to speak with Mrs Kim Howie.

Budget Plan

It was reported that the Council had spent £3,765.76 (which included bank charges) since the start of the new financial year and this was £10,966.49 less expenditure than what was earmarked in the budget for the year.

Review Council's Budget

It was agreed that the finance sub-committee would meet before the next Council meeting and report back at the next meeting with regards to the Council's budget.

Council's Financial Regulations

It was agreed that in section 4.5 the limit for the budgetary provision for the expenditure should be changed from £500, to £2,000 and add "with the agreement of the Chairman and Vice Chairman".

Christmas Lights

The Chairman reported that he had received a list of all the expenditure with regards to the above from Mr. Geraint Williams and it was agreed that the Clerk would forward this to all Members and the matter would be discussed again at next month's meeting.

Election of Councillor

The Clerk reported that she had received a notice of Election from the Electoral Officer and that the notice had commenced since the 8th of this month and was ending on the 16th. If more than one name would be received by him an election will be held on the 13th of June.

Harlech Council Investigation Quotations

Cllr. Martin Hughes reported that he had received 3 quotes from One Voice Wales to carry out the investigation ranging from £945 to £11,000 and he also stated that the remit had been prepared by One Voice Wales and sent out to the three investigators. The Chairman voiced concern that Cllr. Martin Hughes had been able to make contact with One Voice Wales without the permission of the Chairman and that the Council was ready to spend public money on the matter to investigate the fraud. The Chairman also stated that he had no confidence in the quotations received due to the process in which they had been obtained following a conversation with One Voice Wales earlier today where they stated that they can only discuss topics with prior arrangements from the Chairman or the Clerk. A vote was taken to receive the lowest quote and everybody agreed to this.

Public Toilets by the Castle Lease

The Clerk reported following last month's meeting that he had sent copies of the above to all Members so they could have a look at it before the Council contact Gwynedd Council back. It was agreed to reply stating that the Council was not happy with the Lease and to ask if it would be possible a more simpler document and less years on the Lease.

Cyfeillion Ellis Wynne Meeting – 3.5.24

Cllr. Martin Hughes reported that himself and Cllr. Giles Bentham had attended the above meeting on behalf of the Council. It was also reported that minutes of that meeting had been received by everybody. Both Councillors stated that a letter by Cyngor Gwynedd to Cyfeillion Ellis Wynne, dated 7/7/2010, which included a list of the obligations of Cyngor Tref Harlech need to undertake as lease holders, which have not been done, thus far, by the town council' was going to be sent to them by Sian Llewelyn but as yet nothing had been received. It was decided to leave the matter until such letter had been received and to place the matter on next month's agenda.
